## *Reggae in Goshen this Saturday*

**GOSHEN** — The Tarriii band is bringing reggae to The Orange Inn this Saturday, July 17, at 8 p.m.

Born Delroy Pusey in Black River St. Elizabeth, Jamaica, Tarriii started his first band, Perfidians, in 1974 as a guitarist and ended up as the drummer. In 1981 he helped put together another band, Circuit Breakers, which backed up many popular reggae artists, including Yellow Man.

In 1992 Tarriii started playing with the band Special Bru, and opened for acts such as Jimmy Cliff, Burning Spear, Dub Professor, and Eek A Mouse.

Tarriii has played venues ranging from The Beat in Portchester, to the Madison Square Garden theater. He has spent the last three years writing, arranging, and promoting "In Dis Time," a collection of songs.

Tickets to see him at The Orange Inn, located at 161 Main St. in Goshen, are \$12.50 per person or \$20 per couple. There will be a light food menu with vegetarian and nonvegetarian fare, as well as desserts and coffee.
